Dear Mr. Masters,

We, the undersigned, ask that Premier League cancel all matches in the United States for as long as the country remains governed by a racist dictatorship. Since 2020, the league has gone to great lengths to rid itself of the legacy of racism in football, launching the No Room for Racism campaign which has both symbolically and materially improved inclusivity in English football. We are now asking that you hold to that commitment and cancel the upcoming Summer Series fixtures in New Jersey, Chicago, and Atlanta, as well as any matches that might be planned for the regular season.

For the past six months, the world has watched with horror as Donald Trump has unleashed law enforcement and the military on civilians, sweeping whole families up in mistaken immigration raids, holding people in indefinite detention in prisons around the world, and smashing any semblance of due process or civil rights. The way the administration has conducted itself—ruling by executive decree, protecting the lawlessness of police, exacting a genocide against racial and sexual minorities—is nothing short of fascism.

As Premier League fans, we say enough is enough. It is time for the League to stop its financial relationship with the United States so long as it is ruled by a tyrant. Players, coaches, referees, and staff should not be put in harm's way by being made to travel to the US, risking detainment, arrest, interrogation, detention, and deportation at the border and in the streets.

For those of us in the United States, this may be the only opportunity we have to see our favorite club play in a town nearby. However, we are willing to sacrifice this for the good of League personnel and to put pressure on the US administration to respect democracy and the rule of law.

In addition to this petition, we are organizing a boycott of the planned US fixtures, urging those with tickets not to attend or resell, and inviting fans to protest outside the stadiums. We are also organizing fans by club to lobby the locker rooms to take a stand against the normalization of US fascism urging them to sign the petition and boycott the games as well.



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We hope we can work together in the coming weeks to resolve this in a way that supports the struggle of those of us in the US against the tyranny of the Trump regime. We want to see those stadiums empty, of fans and of clubs. So long as despotic xenophobia reigns in the United States, let there be no entertainment from overseas.
